



## CAP 2022 PARENT/PARTICIPANT CONTRACT

As a participant in the CAREER ART PATHS 2022 program, presented by the Doña Ana Arts Council, I agree to the following:

\_\_\_\_\_ will be a PARTICIPANT in the CAREER ART PATHS (CAP) program June 6-10 and June 13-17, 2022, 8:30 AM to 2:00 PM daily. Students will show their work in a student exhibition which will be held during July 2022 at the Doña Ana Arts Council gallery.

1. Participant and his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) will arrange to bring participant to the program each day promptly at 8:30 AM and to pick him/her up promptly at 2:00 PM, unless informed otherwise for field trips. The students understand that they and their parents are responsible for arranging transportation to the program in the mornings and from the program in the afternoons. There will be no supervision of children before or after class.
2. Participant agrees to cooperate with and obey the program coordinator and program facilitators while attending the program activities. Discipline issues detract from the program for everyone. A first occurrence will receive a verbal warning; if there is a second offense, the parents will be called; upon third offense, parents will be notified that participant has been removed from the program and no refund of fees will be given.
3. Casual, comfortable clothing is appropriate. Students should bring an old shirt to wear during art workshops.
4. Participant must be prepared each day with a sack lunch and a drink.
5. Any smoking and use of drugs, alcohol, or any illegal substance will result in removal from the program.
6. Students will not use cell phones during CAP unless it is part of the instruction or an emergency.
7. Participant must attend classes every day unless he/she notifies the program coordinator or program facilitators prior to any absence.
8. There will be no refunds of the registration fee.

The Doña Ana Arts Council, as the program presenter, agrees to the following:

1. Provide a ten-day program that will include guest artists and art activities that will enhance the student's knowledge of the arts, and increase abilities in a variety of career art paths available to an artist
2. Provide all supplies and materials to allow student to complete art projects
3. Provide each student with a tee shirt and CAP certificate of participation
