### **2023 SUMMER SEMESTER COURSES**

**June 19 – July 21, 2023 *Georgia O'Keeffe – Her Life, Her Work and Her Place in the History of Art*; 6- sessions with Kathleen Key, Art Historian & ARTE Co-Founder**

The focus of ARTE's 2023 Summer Semester will be a six-part course of study on Georgia O'Keeffe on Mondays 4 – 5:30 PM In-person and repeated via zoom on Tuesdays 4 – 5:30 PM. (Zoom sessions will be recorded.) In-person classes will be held at the Doña Ana Arts Council, 230 S. Water St., Las Cruces. Park on street or in lot on the corner of Water St. and Amador Ave. Light refreshments will be served.

Registered ARTE students may attend either the in-person class or the zoom class each week. All students will be emailed the zoom recording each week.

This 6-part series explores multiple subjects in the life and time of Georgia O'Keeffe.

- 1- Mon June 19, 4- 5:30 PM in-person; OR  
 Tue June 20, 4 – 5:30 PM via zoom**  
 The first class is an in-depth study of her life and her artwork.
- 2- Mon June 26, 4 -5:30 PM in-person; OR  
 Tue June 27, 4 – 5:30 PM via zoom**

The second class will cover the artwork of many prominent European and American artists who lived and worked during her lifetime, from 1897- 1986. Why study these other artists? Studying the art of the top artists of Europe and America in this almost one-hundred-year time span reveals WHY O’Keeffe is the quintessential American Modernist.

**3- Mon July 3 from 4 -5:30 PM in-person OR Wed July 5, 4 – 5:30 PM via zoom (no class July 4<sup>th</sup>)**

Special attention will be given to Arthur Wesley Dow, how Dow’s work and teaching became the major influence on Georgia O’Keeffe’s artwork.

**4- Mon July 10 from 4 – 5:30 PM in-person OR Tue July 11, 4 – 5:30 via zoom**

Another topic is her husband, Alfred Stieglitz, and why he is considered one of the greats in the field of Modern Photography. He deserves attention and study in the Georgia O’Keeffe story.



**5- Mon July 17 from 4 – 5:30 PM in-person OR**

**Tue July 18, 4-5:30 PM via zoom.** Also, to be covered is Georgia’s homes in Abiquiu and at Ghost Ranch.

**6- Thu July 20 from 4 – 5:30 PM in-person OR**

**Fri July 21 from 1:30 – 3:00 PM via zoom.** Last but not last, we will look at Georgia O’Keeffe’s fashion style and how she used clothes to create what the Brooklyn Museum of Art guest curator, Wanda Corn, called “her public persona”.

Please note: This course is in preparation for the ARTE Adventure to Abiquiu & Santa Fe on October 23- 29. Each in-person class will be repeated via zoom following the in-person session. “All Access” registration allows you flexibility to attend in-person, via zoom, or both, and receive recordings from the zoom sessions.

**June 21, June 28, July 12 and July 19: *The History of Silk, Cotton, Linen and Wool.***

**A 4-part series with Nicholas Dahle, former ARTE instructor and current art history Master’s Degree student at University of Massachusetts, Amherst.**

- 2- Wed June 28 via zoom, History of Cotton
- 3- Wed July 12 via zoom, History of Linen
- 4- Wed July 19 via zoom, History of Wool (final class)

All zoom sessions will be recorded and recording links will be sent to registered ARTE students.

The next ARTE Travel Adventure will be to northern New Mexico to walk in the footsteps of Georgia O'Keeffe with a 7-day trip to Abiquiu, Ghost Ranch and Santa Fe on October 23 – 29, 2023. The trip will include docent-led tours at Georgia O'Keeffe's home in Abiquiu, Ghost Ranch and at the O'Keeffe Art Museum in Santa Fe. There is room for 16 people on this trip (plus ARTE personnel). Preference will be given to those registering for the ARTE Summer '23 Semester and taking the Georgia O'Keeffe course.
